March 3, 1980

The Becker Town Board met on Monday March 3rd at 8:00 p.m. at the Becker Town Hall. Those present were Jacobson, Pouliot, Olson, Edling, Clitty and Myers.

The meeting was called to order by Chairman Jacobson.

The minutes from the February 18th meeting were read. Pouliot moved seconded by Olson to accept the minutes as read. All members voting for.

Edling reported that he had received a quote of \$1328.00 per year for three year period from Midland Insurance Co. for Public Officials Liability Insurance. Also that the policy deleted punitive damages and prior acts. A copy of the policy was being mailed and the Board put off taking any action until the policy was received.

Supervisor Clitty then presented a four part statement as follows:

- 1) That the advice the Board received from it's attorney that no appeal can be made on the Mitchell-Knutson settlement is not true. It can be appealed.
- 2) Do not believe what the Board was told by Attorney Boland about eminent domain.
- 3) That she could never in good conscience build a road that will not meet the specifications set up by the Town Board.
- 4) that she removes herself from all further discussion on the Mitchell-Knutson road.

In discussion that followed it was felt by all members that any expenditures on roads should contain the name of such road.

The Board set up March 29 at 8:00 A.M. as the date it would act on a petition presented to it requesting the Board not to move the road as specified in the Mitchell-Knutson settlement. The meeting to be at the road site. Olson moved to appeal the settlement on the Mitchell-Knutson Road. Motion failed due to a lack of a second.

Other meetings coming up include a zoning meeting on March 6th in Elk River and a weed inspectors meeting March 18th at the Becker Town Hall at 7:30 P.M. Regarding the zoning meeting the purpose of which is zoning change, the Board would be opposed to any change.

Edling moved seconded by Clitty to pay warrants 3757 through 3770. All members voting for.

March 17, 1980

The Becker Town Board met on Monday Mar. 17th at 8:00 P.M. at the Becker Town Hall. Those present were Jacobson, Pouliot, Olson, Edling, Clitty, Schwinn, and Myers.

The Meeting was called to order by Chairman Jacobson.

The minutes from the March 3rd meeting were read. Edling moved seconded by Clitty to accept the minutes as read. All members voting for.

The minutes from the March 4th Board of Audit Meeting were read. Olson moved seconded by Pouliot to accept the minutes as read. All members voting for.

Reelected board member Pouliot and newly elected clerk Schwinn took their oath's of office as administered by Chairman Jacobson.

~~Norm~~ Schmidt and Duane Peterson were present regarding a previous request to extend 60th Ave. $\frac{1}{2}$ mile farther west. In discussion that followed several options were brought up including the feasibility of upgrading the entire road. Pouliot mentioned that at one point the river runs very close to the road and may pose a grading problem. The Board agreed to view the road when the weather breaks and make a decision.

Pouliot reported that Hannon Excavating will no longer be doing the Township roads. Three other contractors have been contacted regarding taking over the road maintenance. Brenteson's of Big Lake felt he had all he could handle all ready. Baurly Brothers of Sauk Rapids is pretty far away. Mike Schendzielos of Clear Lake was present and said he was prepared to take over the maintenance of the roads. After a few questions from the Board, Edling moved seconded by pouliot to hire Schendzielos to maintain the Township roads. All members voting for.

Glenn Radeke Sr. gave a short report on the fire board.

Pouliot reminded everyone of the weed inspections meeting at the Town Hall on Mar 18th.

Eding reported that he had received 3 bids on Public Officials Liability Insurance. Santiago Insurance Agency bid \$1469 for 1 year with a \$2500 deductible. Twin Pines Agency bid \$1396 for 1 year with a \$500 deductible. Midland Insurance Co. bid \$1328 per year for a 3 year period with a \$1000 deductible. Clitty moved seconded by Olson to accept the recommendation of Edlig to accept the bid of Midland Insurance Co. Voting for Pouliot, Olson, Edling, and Clitty. Opposed: Jacobson. Motion passed. Edling also reported he had received a premium notice from Twin Pines Agency for \$110 for insurance on the Town Hall. Edling moved seconded by Clitty to pay the premium of \$110 to Twin Pines Agency. All voting for.

Discussion was held on the zoning ordinance rewriting to be done by the Zoning Commission. Leslie Fisher, Beckers representative, has asked for a meeting with the Town Board to discuss what items the Board would like to see incorporated. The Board would like her to come in on April 7th.

The new Chairman for the year will be G. Jean Clitty.

Acorn Lane had been transferred back and forth between the County and Becker Township. Until The County had vacated in 1971. Mr. Nidecker did not have all the information needed at the present time and requested to return at the April 21, 1980 meeting.

Leslie Fisher, representative of the Becker Township for the Zoning Commision made her report to the Township Board. She reported that Dennis Schuette of Big Lake wanted more time to dispose of the 2½ million old tires on his property. There also was a conditional use permit granted to Larry Possehl for a trailer home on his fathers property in section 25 of Becker Township because of hardship. The Planning Commission wants more involvment by the Township Board. They are proposing to enlarge aræa in the County to A-1 which is primarily agriculture.
