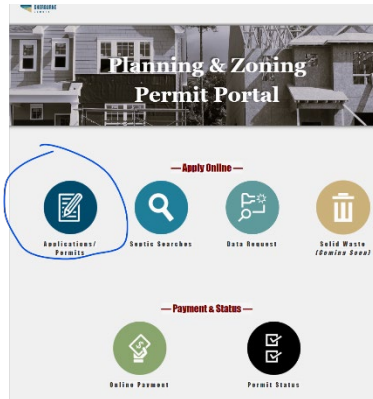


Land Use Permit – Becker Township

1. Click Applications/Permits'
